


Training Options for *The ASAM Criteria*



Promoting Engagement

In-service or keynote presentations establish a foundational interest in the Criteria. Live or virtual orientation training builds initial understanding.

Establishing a Foundation

The book and eTraining build a strong foundation for increasing knowledge. Two-day trainings guide participants and include case studies and skill practice.

Solidifying the Core

Coaching, booster training and one-to-one consultation enhances real-world implementation and offers continuous quality improvement through observation and feedback.

Increasing Sustainability

Change Agent Training provides skills to identify and improve program design and sustain effective use of the Criteria system-wide. Coaching and use of the ASAM Criteria Change Agent Support Tool helps to promote proper use.

Establishing a Foundation

ASAM Criteria eLearning Modules

Completing the ASAM Criteria eLearning modules is an effective way to prepare participants for in-person trainings as well as serving as an additional reference and post-training reinforcement tool. The modules can strengthen supervision when used as part of a structured coaching plan (e.g., part of “Change Agent” coaching plans). The modules allow providers to revisit key content areas and to promote ongoing fidelity to the ASAM Criteria. **While the optional eLearning modules are good preparatory materials, they cannot be used in lieu of the required two-day ASAM Criteria Skill-building training.**

Each module discusses different parts of *The ASAM Criteria*, and information is reinforced through knowledge checks and final exams that learners must pass in order to receive credit. Skills that reinforce the learning objectives are practiced and applied through interactive case studies and followed up with review from Chief Editor of *The ASAM Criteria*, Dr. David Mee-Lee.

Two-day ASAM Criteria Skill-building Training

This two-day, application-focused training provides participants with an in-depth look at the theoretical foundations of the Criteria, including clinically driven services, biopsychosocial assessment, the six dimensions, continued stay and transfer/discharge criteria. Incorporating the use of the new edition of *The ASAM Criteria*, participants have opportunities for skill practice at every stage of the treatment process: assessment, engagement, treatment planning, continuing care and transfer or discharge. All participants receive an in-depth Training Journal to guide the training experience and as a resource for continuing skill application.
